

Conditions of participation of mediation link persons

Each project team identifies a mediation link person among its team members.

The mediation link person shall:

- communicate with teams of selected ECML projects related to their own project ;
- communicate relevant information to the wider audience (e.g. sending project news to relevant networks, webmasters, newsletter editors);
- participate in meetings of ECML projects which have been identified as related to their own project, at their instigation and upon request to the Centre.

Following consultation between the mediation link persons of the projects concerned, the coordinator of the project team holding a meeting shall communicate the name(s) of mediation link person(s) who should be invited by the ECML to Margit.Huber@ecml.at no later than 8 weeks prior to the meeting.

Teams of **development projects** can **invite up to 2** mediation link persons from other related ECML projects **to each of their events** (in most cases it is anticipated that this will be to workshops and/or network meetings). A mediation link person from a related project will attend a maximum of two meetings of the project within the duration of the programme.

Teams of **mediation projects** can **invite up to 4** mediation link persons of other related ECML projects **to each of their events** (in most cases it is anticipated that this will be to workshops and/or network meetings). A mediation link person from a related project will attend a maximum of two meetings of the project within the duration of the programme.

In exceptional cases the participation at a meeting of a related project can be delegated to another team member.
